



Prompt like a pro

A quick-reference guide to help you get started with Enscape Premium and integrate Veras into your design workflow.

Prompting principles

Language

Prompts must be in **English** only.

Composition

Use **commas** to separate ideas.

- brown carpet, black sofa, living room
- a living room with a black sofa and a brown carpet

Emphasis

Use parentheses to strengthen focus.

- (((on the moon))) > (with view of Earth)

Clarity

Be clear and detailed, not vague.

- timber building
- timber construction

Specificity

More detail = better outputs.

- white walls, large windows, forest outside
- white room in a forest

Avoid over-constraining

Too-specific = poor render.

- black mesh office chair, office
- ((Steelcase Series 2 Model B08L8J6BYV))

Prompt order matters

- Words at the **start** of the prompt get more attention!

Framing tips

Frame shots like a photographer!

- Straight-on, 2-point perspective
- Obscure angles, wide/distorted views

Prompt examples

- modern design with large windows, interior lights, timber building, winter, blizzard
- villa in a city, white paneling, blue glazing, golden hour
- cabin in desert, blue glass windows, sandstone, summer
- white walls, gray wood floor, forest outside large windows

Prompt anatomy guide

These are some characteristics that can make up a prompt. The examples are not exhaustive.

Category	Examples
Subject*	Interior, exterior, cabin, villa, car
Season	Summer, winter, spring, autumn (not "fall")
Weather	Sunny, overcast, blizzard, rain
Time of day	Morning, golden hour, night (adjust scene for night shots)
Lighting	Interior lights, soft lighting, cinematic lighting
Color	Green glass, gold frame, white walls
Style	Modern, rustic, minimal, monolithic
Aesthetic	Watercolor, charcoal, oil painting, surreal, 8k
Effects	Bokeh, sharp focus, sharp edges

*Subject - what is shown in the scene; use the *Is Interior* toggle in Veras for interior renderings

Prompt testing tips

- Render each prompt in 4 batches to test random seeds.
- Start simple → test → add more detail step-by-step.
- Use ChatGPT to co-build prompts!
